

Evans High School
Top Ten List of Accomplishments
2007-2008

1. On the FCAT School grade, Evans High School improved 50 points – the highest improvement in Orange County among high schools.
2. Evans High School was #1 out of 18 OCPS high schools in Learning Gains of the Lower 25% in Reading – 55%.
3. Evans High School was #1 out of 18 OCPS high schools in Learning Gains of the Lower 25% in Math – 78%.
4. Evans High School posted the best scores in school history in six out of eight categories of the school grade: Percent meeting standards in Reading (26), Math (57) and Science (18). Percent with Learning Gains in Reading (44), Math (76) and Lower 25 in Math (78).
5. Evans High School was authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) as an International Baccalaureate-Middle Years Program school.
6. Evans High School received SACS Accreditation from the Southern Association through 2012 and received six commendations in the process.
7. Evans High School IB coordinator Jennifer Bohn was selected Orange County Teacher of the Year and was one of five finalists for the State of Florida Teacher of the Year.
8. The Evans High School BETA club published a book, “Everyone has a story to tell,” after interviewing homeless adults. Led by BETA club sponsor Jennifer Bohn, this book earned major publicity in Central Florida and around the state.
9. The following accomplishments occurred in athletics, activities and the arts: Evans High School went from 7 student clubs in 06-07 to 37 student organizations in 07-08; 2008 Yearbook wins Gold Award for design; 2008 Chorus wins “Spirit of Chicago” award; 2008 Band wins Martin Luther King award; 2008 Navy Junior ROTC rated top 100 in the nation and earns distinguished unit for the third consecutive year; 2008 Men’s Basketball team advanced to FHSAA Final Four and the 2008 Cheerleading team finished 10th in the state in the inaugural FHSAA competitive cheerleading state finals.
10. The following accomplishments occurred in advanced studies: In the IB-MYP Program, Evans High School recruited and maintained 75 freshman students in the 07-08 school year with the plan for 170 in 9th and 10th grade in 08-09; In the Advanced Placement programs, Evans High School increased AP offerings from 11 courses in 06-07 to 15 courses in 07-08 with the plan to increase to 20 AP courses in 08-09 and in the AVID program, Evans High School went from 15 students in 06-07 to 70 students in 07-08 with the plan for 150 students in 08-09.
